Swimming Lessons

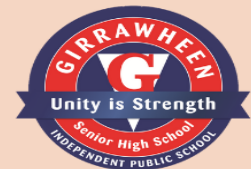


Swimming lessons are being held this term during Weeks 9 and 10, 13th to 24th September.

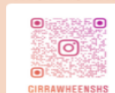
